



Located at 599 East Broadway in Eugene OR, Bridges on Broadway is a Hotel being operated by Homes for Good Housing Agency to provide 50 rooms that temporarily lodge individuals and families that lost their homes to the devastating Holiday Farm Fire in 2020.

The former Hotel was purchased by Lane County with a grant from Oregon Community Foundation. Once the hotel is no longer used to lodge people and families displaced by the wildfires, Homes for Good plans to convert the Hotel into Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) units that would house individuals struggling with homelessness.

### Housing Details

- Renovation of four-story building
- Conversion of 50 hotel rooms to furnished studio apartments
- New Community room with kitchen
- New On-site laundry on each floor
- On-site parking
- New Offices for supportive services and property management
- New Secure bike storage
- New Pet relief area
- Increase to 12 fully accessible ADA units
- Access to public transportation
- All 50 units will receive Project Based Voucher Rental Assistance
- Project Team includes Pinnacle Architecture and Meili Construction
- Construction anticipated to begin spring of 2024

### Program Services

- 24/7 on-site staff
- On-site maintenance staff
- On-site supportive services and case management
- Social and recreational health
- Connections to mainstream resources, health care, substance abuse treatment programs, mental health services, self-health groups, and peer resources
- Connections to employment and educational services
