

Lazy Days is located on the north side of the McKenzie Hwy at 52511 McKenzie River Hwy. The park was completely destroyed in the Holiday Farm fire in the fall of 2020 and Homes for Good is completely rebuilding the park to provide 20 spaces for modular and an additional 10 spaces for park model RVs as well a community building, playground, and other amenities. Modular homes include DHP heating/air conditioning unit and offer energy efficient appliances. Modular homes also feature in-unit laundry, and the property has laundry facilities in the community room for Park Model RVs. Each resident's driveway includes off-street parking spaces for up to 3 vehicles.

Homes for Good is working closely with OHCS, Lane County, and assigned case managers to work with individuals and families that were displaced by the Holiday Farm Fire to connect them to this housing opportunity. The project will address inequitable access to high quality housing in low-income rural communities and community revitalization post disaster.




































2-BEDROOM MODULAR HOME FLOOR PLAN
