In the Matter of documenting the Executive
Director's Annual Performance Evaluation and
Instructing Human Resources Regarding
Revision of the Employment Agreement

WHEREAS, Homes for Good believes that its employees are the organization's most valuable assets; and

WHEREAS, Jacob Fox began his tenure as Homes for Good Housing Agency Executive Director on July 1st 2015; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fox's employment contract contains a provision regarding how merit increases may occur; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fox's annual performance evaluation has been conducted with a positive result; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fox has indicated his intention to continue his employment with Homes for Good Housing Agency; and

WHEREAS the Homes for Good Housing Agency board has directed Human Resources regarding revisions of his new employment agreement; and

WHEREAS Chair Char Reavis is authorized to execute a new employment agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Jacob Fox continue his employment with Homes for Good in the position of Executive Director and that a new employment agreement for Jacob Fox be drafted to reflect the merit increase of 5% of gross salary as allowed by employment contract, it is proposed that this merit increase be retroactive to March 26, 2020.
