Homes for Good is accepting wait list pre-applications to be placed on waiting lists for one-, two-, three-, and four-bedroom single-story duplexes for low-income residents at the Oregon Coast. Laurelwood Homes lies just west of the intersection of Highways 101 and 126, between 10th and 11th, and between Maple and Laurel Streets in Florence. Rent and utilities are based upon 30% of household income. Residents pay for electric only. Water, sewer, and garbage are included with the rent. Move-in costs include a prorated first-month's rent and a \$275 to \$650 deposit, depending upon the bedroom size. Homes for Good can assist applicants in obtaining a guaranteed loan for the deposit, repayable over six months at a reasonable interest rate. Laurelwood features washer-dryer hookups, yards, on-site laundry facilities, a community center and quick access to local shopping. Residents may have a small dog or cat with a \$200 deposit and an approved pet application. To qualify, applicants must meet low-income guidelines and occupancy standards. One-bedroom units are reserved for elderly and disabled residents.
