How much is the rent?

The current contract rent, as of February 2021, is \$555 per month for a one-bedroom apartment, and \$651 per month for a two-bedroom apartment. This may not be the rent amount when a household reaches the top of the list.

Are your waitlists first come/first serve? How are they "organized"?

The waitlist is first-come first-serve in order of date and time the application is received.

How many occupants can live in a unit?

For a one-bedroom unit, you are required to have a minimum of one member and a maximum of three. For a two-bedroom unit, you are required to have a minimum of two members and a maximum of five.

How long will I be on the waitlist before I can move in?

It is hard for us to predict wait times because we have to wait for a vacancy from another tenant before there is an opening for someone on the list. This means someone could be on a wait list anywhere from six months to two years or longer. From past data we expect one unit to become available each year

How much do I have to make to qualify for this unit?

To qualify you must meet low income guidelines AND have at least \$1,110 in monthly income for a one-bedroom apartment or \$1,302 in monthly income for a two-bedroom apartment OR hold a Section 8 youcher.

The income limit for 2021 are:

1 person: \$39,200 per year 2 persons: \$44,800 per year 3 persons: \$50,400 per year 4 persons: \$56,000 per year 5 persons: \$60,500 per year

Is this waitlist for subsidized housing?
